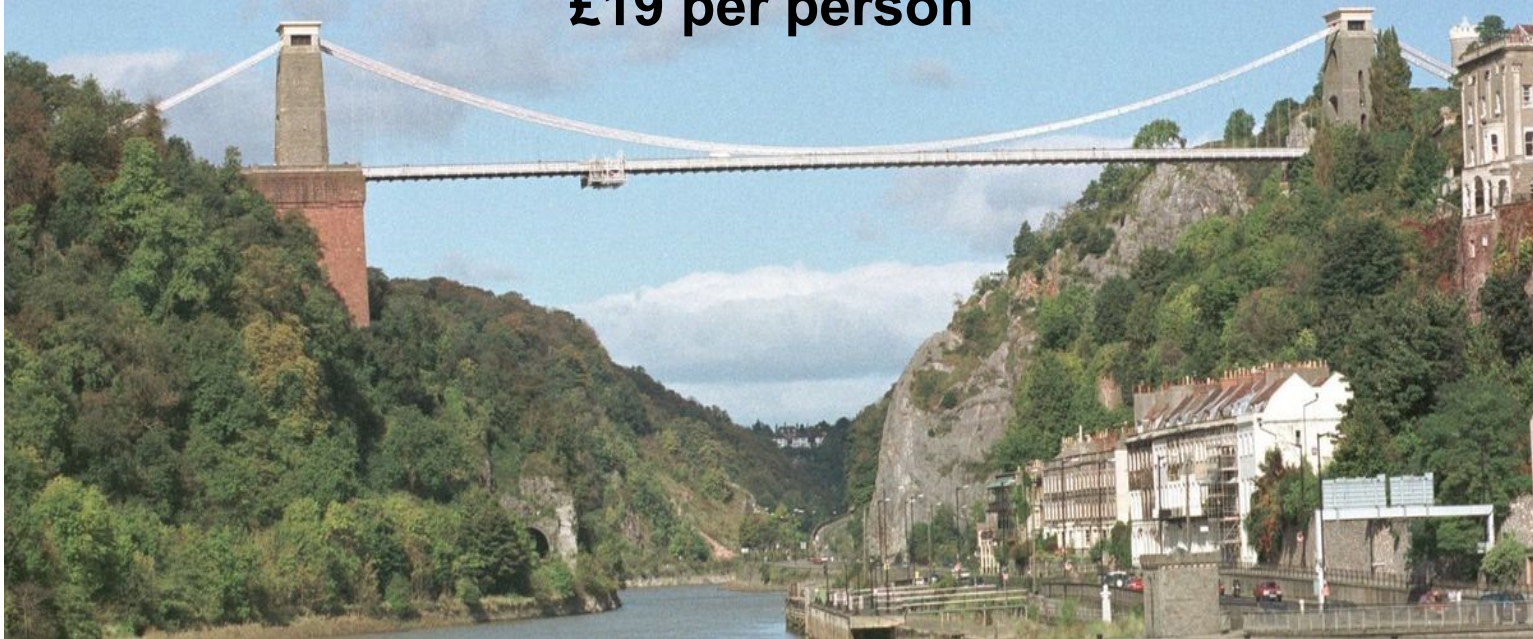


Chalfonts U3A Excursion - Friday 18 May 2018

Our tour takes place on and across the Clifton Suspension Bridge where we shall learn about the competition to design the bridge, a project plagued with problems and how the end result differed from the original design. Our guide will tell us about Brunel and his family, explain how a suspension bridge works and how people crossed the gorge before it was built. We'll hear some amazing stories about the people who used and maintained the bridge and the things that are done today to keep it working.



At the end of our Bridge Tour the rest of the day is free for you to have lunch and visit Bristol's many attractions - either on foot, on the Tourist In-sight Hop On/Off bus or the local City buses. Bristol's harbourside is now a modern development with restaurants, bars and shops and houses the famous **SS Great Britain Ship** which changed history and the newly opened **BRUNEL Museum - "Being Brunel"**.

Our coach will be leaving Bristol at 5pm from the Harbourside short stay car park. We shall supply maps of Bristol so that you can take full advantage of this day out in the South West and enjoy the sights of the City.
